



APPLY HOW?

God can definitely highlight an area from the Bible that you need to apply to your own life. Identify and commit to something you sense the Spirit is leading you to do in obedience to what you read. Make it specific enough that you can do it within the week, and make it personal enough that you yourself can do it (and not someone else). If you have a close friend, share with them for accountability if you want

EXAMPLE: When doing personal Bible reading, you can regularly ask if God might be 1) teaching me something, 2) telling me to stop doing something I am doing, 3) correcting some wrong thinking or behavior, or 4) preparing me to live more effectively for him.



WORTH SHARING?

Is there someone who might benefit from hearing what you've seen or learned in your time with God? Write their name down. Whether a believer or not-yet believer, we all can encourage each other in God's good news and truth. How can you share the joy, peace, and conviction you've been given by God with others?

EXAMPLE: Questions are great conversation starters. If you have learned about God's discipline recently in studying Revelation 3:19, you could ask a friend, "Discipline can stink when it happens. But what ways do you think it shows love?"



ANY QUESTIONS?

With every question you ask, try and answer your own question before going to others for help. Some of the deepest, most lasting learning we do comes when we press ourselves to search the Bible for an answer to our own question. The answer might be in the verse we are studying, or in the surrounding chapter or book, or God may bring to mind a verse or verses elsewhere in the Bible. Stop, pray, ask, and do your best.

EXAMPLE: Why did God have people write songs and then keep them for us today in the book of Psalms? Why is Psalms the most quoted Old Testament book in the New Testament?

BIBLE STUDY TIPS

SEE JESUS?

Where do you see Jesus in what you are reading? In Luke 24:44 Jesus did say the whole Bible is about him, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled."

EXAMPLE: I know Jesus will return to reign in Jerusalem. Are the feet described in Zechariah 14:4, the feet of Jesus? The feet of the coming Messiah?




WHAT SHINES?



HIGHLIGHT

As we read passages in the Bible, many times there are parts that things to mind. Reading the Bible is an opportunity to hear what is on God's heart. The Spirit can highlight areas of Scripture for specific prayer purposes, which we can then talk to God about.



GOSPEL-CENTERED

At the core of God's Word is His plan. Any time we pray out of the Bible, our prayer should be anchored in the truth of that plan. God, and our prayers to Him, should not be treated like a magic genie in a bottle who gives me whatever I want. He has a plan and His desire is that our prayers would align with it.
